Our painter has not given us a date yet, but I will not forget to take some photos once the kitchen walls have been painted as I agreed.

Have been trying to activate the guarantees for the hob, oven and microwave and they all ask for proof of date of purchase. Can you please scan receipts and send them out to me.

Obviously the outstanding balance will need to be adjusted now that the 'block' was added and the bin was excluded. Please send us a revised Invoice for the balance at your earliest convenience.
